
## Tips for Studying the Bible



· [	Read the intro to the book of the Bible you're reading Look at the outline of the book to get the rough idea of the flow Read the notes on the bottom/side of your passage for additiona nformation
Lc	ook for the big picture
•	Get the general feel and flow of the book you're studying Read through the whole book of the Bible at a brisk pace Write out a short outline of the main points
Re	ead your passage closely
•	Are there examples of repetition? Are there promises or commands? Does it say anything about God's character? Are there people, places, customs, nations, etc. that could use additional research?

•	Nouns: people, places, customs, etc. (ex. Donkey) The book of the Bible you're studying The author of the book of the Bible The audience the book was originally intended for (ex. Corinth)
U:	se a Commentary (optional)
